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AN OVERVIEW

Sant Parmanand Hospitals traces its illustrious origins back to 1933 when it was founded as an Eye Hospital by the revered Sant Parmanand Ji of Bhagwat Bhakti Ashram in Rawari. Established with the noble mission for providing free treatment to the poor and needy, the hospital has grown exponentially over the decades. Relocating to its present site in Delhi in 1955, the hospital's journey of transformation culminated on 2nd October 1997, with the commissioning of the current state-of-the-art Multi-Specialty Tertiary Care Hospital in civil Lines.

Today, Sant Parmanand group of Hospitals stands as a beacon of excellence in the medical community, recognized both nationally and internationally. This 153-bed facility at Civil lines is recognized for its unparalleled medical expertise, exceptional nursing care, and cutting-edge diagnostic services while the new Hospital is attracting attention from all over Delhi and NCR for its ultramodern facilities.

Sant Parmanand group has rightfully earned its place as a leading healthcare centre of excellence from ensuring the wellbeing of the society to training the next generation of healthcare providers through its DNB programme and Nursing School.

IN THE YEAR GONE BY

This year has been exciting for our group as we have expanded our services across all units. A Fetal Medicine & Genetic Testing Department has been established at our Civil Lines Hospital, which will play a significant role in ensuring the well-being of both mothers and babies. The installation of a new rTMS machine will set a new benchmark in treating various psychiatric and neurological conditions, including depression, obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD), and post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

The bed capacity at Yamuna Bazaar Hospital has increased from 102 to 109. We have also completed 1,000 robotic surgeries in orthopaedics and seen a significant increase in patients in the Departments of Medicine and Nephrology. Additionally, in support of our commitment to education, ten more seats have been added to train the next generation of nursing professionals.

NOTE FROM SECRETARY



The year gone by has been an eventful year for the hospital. We had a huge setback due to the unprecedented floods in Delhi in August 2023. The hospital building at Jamuna bazaar was inundated and was out of operation for around 2-3 months resulting in a huge dent to our revenues. However, damage to equipment and stores was covered by insurance. With the efforts and foresightedness of the administrative and medical personnel, all patients were shifted to the civil lines building in good time.

Despite the above calamity, our total income in FY 23-24 increased to an all-time high of Rs. 167 crores as against Rs. 144 crores in the previous year. Surplus during the year was Rs. 1.9 crores (Rs. 2.3 crores in the previous year). Concessions granted to the needy were Rs. 9.5 crores (Rs. 8.4 crores in the previous year). The surplus was affected mainly due to loss of revenue during floods without any corresponding reduction in fixed expenses.

The hospital at Civil Lines is now running at full capacity round the year. New equipment has been added in the departments of neurology, urology and gastroenterology. Efforts are underway to replace the old machines and equipment. The cardiac center being run by Artemis has now been fully taken over by Sant Parmanand Hospital on as is where is basis.

The new hospital at Jamuna Bazaar is also picking up. The robotic machine installed earlier has been receiving a very good response. The hospital should get a major boost with the addition of cardiac and other departments in addition to the orthopedic department. A new Cath lab is in process of being installed in the premises.

The nursing college being run by the hospital at Burari is gradually making a name for itself. We began with a capacity of 20 students per year and are now enrolling 50 students per year.

In line with the current need to be environment friendly, the hospital plans to install equipment for solar generation of power on the available roof areas of both the hospitals and the nursing college. This will also reduce our electricity bills.

As in all other spheres, the field of medicine is undergoing rapid changes. With the help of technology, treatments and procedures are constantly evolving resulting in lower costs and faster recovery time for patients. The management endeavors to keep abreast of the latest developments and live up to its motto of providing the best treatment to every section of society.

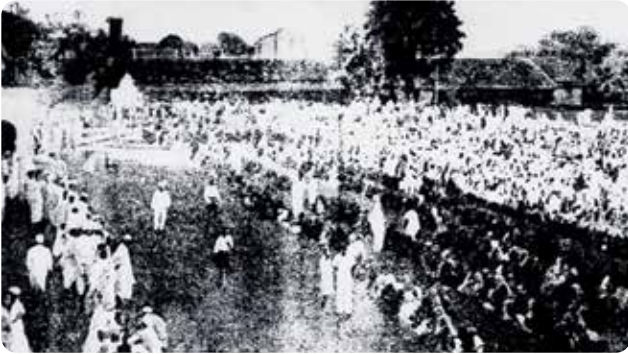

Readers of The Statesman and its local contemporaries are often shocked by letters written to the Editor by citizens complaining of uncleanliness and callousness they encounter in State-run hospitals and dispensaries in the city. It makes a pleasant change for us therefore, to hear from a correspondent about an eye hospital financed and managed by a charitable trust in Alipur Road in the building which several decades ago was the birthplace of All India Radio.

An old retainer of our correspondent whom he had pensioned off some years ago, a man of 80, turned up from his village, sightless in one eye because of a cataract. After a week of his examination by one of the panel doctors he was admitted to the hospital where, the following day, an operation was performed successfully. Our correspondent was most impressed by the general tidiness of the place, the sense of responsibility in the male attendants (female for women patients) and cleanliness of the bed sheets and blankets provided for each patient. But what really amazed him was the cost. A pre-payment of Rs. 48 covered the operation, the laboratory tests and boarding and lodging for a week.

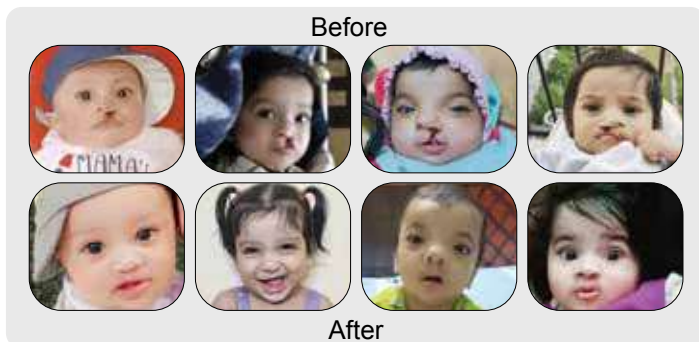
Free OPD

Free Surgeries

1493 Free surgeries of all types were performed for the poor patients. This is 30% of all surgeries performed in the hospital.

Our Department of Orthopaedics stands as a beacon of medical excellence in Delhi and North India. Renowned for its expertise and reputation, the department offers top-tier treatment for complex orthopedic conditions, joint replacements, sports injuries, and emergency surgeries with unmatched proficiency. Our department is equipped with specialized units dedicated to Hip and Knee Replacement Surgery, Sports Medicine and Arthroscopic (keyhole) Surgery, Spine Surgery, Ankle and Foot Surgery, Hand Surgery, and Pediatric Orthopedic Surgery. This comprehensive approach ensures that patients receive the most specialized care tailored to their individual needs. The department is led by Dr. Shekhar Srivastav, a pioneer in North India for introducing Robotic Knee Replacement Surgery. He is also an expert in joint replacement and arthroscopic surgeries. Supported by a team of highly skilled orthopedic consultants, each specializing in different branches of orthopedics, the department works collaboratively to offer patients the latest surgical techniques and personalized care.



With a team of clinicians renowned for their excellence, Sant Parmanand Hospital has become a trusted destination for orthopedic surgeries, attracting patients not only from Delhi and neighboring states but also from overseas. The department conducts daily free and private outpatient clinics, treating approximately 25,000 patients annually and performing over 3,000 surgeries. Among these, about 1,200 are hip and knee replacements, with the department recently achieving a milestone of 1,000 robotic surgeries—a testament to the trust patients place in the team. The department is also a leader in orthopedic education and research. Since 2002, it has been offering the Diplomate of National Board (DNB) Post-Graduate Course, training over 40 doctors who have gone on to become accomplished orthopedic surgeons. Additionally, the department runs a robust Fellowship Programme in Joint Replacement Surgery and Arthroscopy, attracting surgeons from across India and abroad. More than 100 clinical fellows have sharpened their skills here, gaining invaluable experience.

With a strong focus on research, the department has published over 25 articles in peer-reviewed national and international medical journals. The consultants are frequently invited to national and international conferences, where they demonstrate live surgical techniques and ICD lessons to the next generation of surgeons. This advanced technology positions the hospital as one of the first in the region to offer state-of-the-art treatment for a range of psychiatric and neurological disorders. The rTMS machine provides non-invasive, painless therapy, proving highly beneficial for conditions like depression, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), stroke recovery, Parkinson's disease, migraines, multiple sclerosis, autism, epilepsy, fibromyalgia, and chronic pain.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology SPH

The year 2022-23 was an extremely eventful year for the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology Sant Parmanand Hospital. Dr. Nirjala Agarwal (FRCOG) retired after a meritorious service of 25 years and was given on farewell in July'22. The Department was established under her supervision in the year 1998 she was succeeded by Dr. Sonal Bathla as Head of the Department.

- The Department was accredited for DNB by the National Board of Examination and both Primary & Secondary DNB students joined after selection through NEET 2023.
- Labour room facility of the Department of Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Sant Parmanand Hospital successfully cleared Manyata assessment, conducted on 6th Sept 2022, by the FOGSI-NPMU team. Manyata certifies providers a chance to spearhead the quality movement in maternal care in India.
- A High Dependency Unit in Labour room was Inaugurated by Sh Surender Sharma and Dr S. Rajagopal on 20/10/22. This facility provides high end care to high risk patients and is one of its kind in entire North Delhi.
